Prohibited Items



All items must be in your normal household use for 6 months or more. To highlight this, it is best not to pack in original boxes.



Cleaning supplies



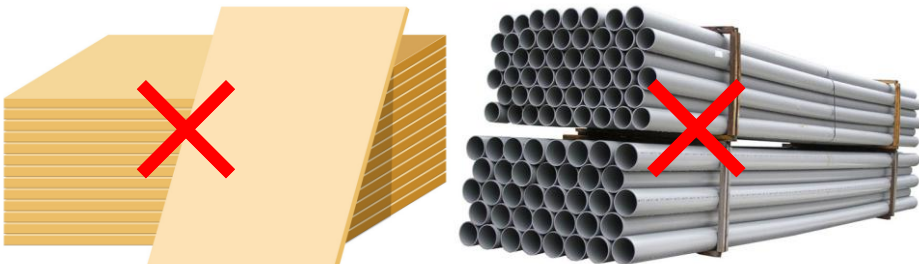
Anything that goes in your mouth or in your body, such as toiletries and grooming products.



Items that are smaller and extremely valuable such as jewelry, coins, and collectables of all types



Any collections or a large enough quantity of any item so that it could be considered sufficient to start a business or to sell



Building construction materials



Automotive parts



CDs and DVDs must be store bought. "Pirated" recordings are prohibited.



Pornographic materials



Large batteries



Scientific instruments



Anything alcoholic



Illegal narcotic substances and devices



Food products, including animal food



Insecticides



Taxidermy



Human and animal ashes



Anything live, such as plants, seeds, etc.



Medications, nutritional supplements, and medical supplies



Weapons, including guns, knives, etc. as well as ammunition



Bulk leather and fabric



Anything archeological



Items that contain flammable liquids must be completely drained of fuel to be permitted



Locked items must be unlocked when loaded onto the truck to be permitted
